## **Procedures**

- 1. All bus drivers (regular, staff and volunteers) must be appointed to the list of approved drivers in order to be permitted to drive a Division owned bus.
- 2. Appointment of regular or spare bus drivers will take place once the following have been received, verified, and approved by Central Office:
  - 2.1 "Application to Drive a School Bus" (Form 613-1)
  - 2.2 Copy of a valid Alberta Class 1, 2 or 4 Operator's License
  - 2.3 Holder of S Endorsement Course
    - 2.3.1 Effective March 1, 2019, bus drivers must successfully complete the S-Endorsement before driving a school bus.
  - 2.3 Hold a valid First Aid certificate (New Drivers have 6 months to obtain)
  - 2.4 Driver's Abstract
  - 2.5 Criminal Record Check
  - 2.6 Child Welfare Check
  - 2.7 3 Year Employment History
  - 2.8 Minimum of three suitable references
  - 2.9 Minimum three years with a non-graduated driver's license.
  - 3. Appointment of staff or volunteer drivers will take place once the following have been received, verified, and approved by Central Office:
    - 3.1 "Application to Drive a School Bus" (Form 613-1) Applications are approved by the Principal and forwarded to Central Office.
    - 3.2 Valid class of license for school bus being driven
    - 3.3 S-Endorsement must be successfully completed before transporting students.
    - 3.4 Hours of Service Training (must be completed by November of new school year)
    - 3.5 WHIMIS training (must be completed by November of new school year)
    - 3.6 First Aid/CPR (if bus driver is also the supervisor Emergency First Aid Level B CPR if another person in a supervisory position has first aid then it is not necessary for the school based bus driver to have First Aid/CPR.)
    - 3.7 Copy of current driver's license on file
    - 3.8 Current year driver abstract on file
    - 3.9 Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check (if not one on employee file)
