# 12. DIRECTOR OF TEACHING QUALITY AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT

The Director provided a report for the trustees to review. The Director prepared videos to provide an overview of each of the digital resources available to teachers to use with their lesson development and to support student learning through intervention and/or extension. The Director prepared reflection questions to help facilitate the August 28 PLN Session with teachers. The sessions were held virtually either by their grade/subject and teachers held discussions and made plans around focus area(s) for this year. Alberta Profesisonal Learning Consortium hosted a summer symposium. This information was shared with teachers and administrators. If you were not able to attend a session you registered for the recording was emailed to you. K-3 Literary & Numeracy screeners will continue this year. Alberta Education has adjusted the timeline for them.

### 13. ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF FAITH AND FORMATION

The Assistant Superintendent provided a report for the trustees to review. She is preparing for Mission & Ministry day. The Assistant Superintendent has compiled religion resources for teachers that have been assigned religion courses this year. September 8 will be a training day for K-8 teachers. School faith visits added grade 5 & 6 this year to meet with the teachers to empower them and show them what a lesson in faith looks like.

# 14. SECRETARY-TREASURERS REPORT

The Secretary-Treasurer provided a report for the trustees to review. The Secretary-Treasurer provided a revenue update for 2025-2026. Summer School students at School of Hope achieved 849.5 credits. Buffalo Trail is no longer charging ECACS for the School of Choice/Cross Boundary fees. Riders who live outside a Catholic formation can sign a transportation declaration, which allows BTPS to claim "full" funding for students living outside a Catholic formation.
