Students should have access to a comprehensive educational program. Distance Education courses provide acceptable alternatives to small high schools in the Division that can offer only a limited number of courses in any single year.

Procedures

- 1. The Principal shall be responsible to approve the registration of students in all Distance Education courses.
- 2. The Principal shall determine the rate of reimbursement of fees in accordance with the following:
 - 2.1 100% of the course fees will be paid by the school if:
 - 2.1.1 Timetable conflicts prevent a student from taking a required course by regular instruction during a particular school year;
 - 2.1.2 Limited student enrolments prevent the course from being offered in the school during a particular school year; or
 - 2.1.3 The Principal recommends a student enroll in a Distance Education course due to extenuating circumstances.
 - 2.2 Fifty percent of the course fees will be paid by the school if:
 - 2.2.1 A student wishes to take an optional course that is not offered by the school:
 - 2.2.2 A resident student in a home schooling program is enrolled in a Distance Education course.
- 3. Reimbursement of course costs will be dependent upon approval of the Principal and submission of evidence of the successful completion of the course.
